This program is for parents and guardians of students with learning disabilities and/or ADHD in Grade 7 or 8 in Ontario.

Overview

The Parent Workshop Series is a virtual, parent-only program consisting of 4 online sessions. This program was designed by the Regional Assessment and Resource Centre (RARC) to support students with learning disabilities and ADHD as they transition from elementary to post-secondary school by providing programming to their parents/guardians.

Based on the parent component of RARC's long-running STEPS (Successful Transition from Elementary to Post-Secondary) program, the Parent Workshop Series will offer parents this same valuable content in a virtual format.

The goal of the sessions is to provide parents:

- Information and support to understand their child's experience and potential more fully
- Skills to navigate the school system
- Ability to provide timely and targeted support
- Support to know they are not alone
