Responsible Futures Student Auditor - Call for Applicants

The Queen's Office of the Principal, in partnership with the AMS - Office of the Sustainability Commissioner is seeking students interested in sustainability education to be part of our first cohort of Responsible Futures Student Auditors. Student Auditors will be supported by a Responsible Futures staff member to work in a team to assess Queen's progress towards embedding sustainable development in learning across the University. The Responsible Futures audit will aim to assess progress for education for sustainable development (ESD) at Queen's University. Students and staff have spent the last few months collecting evidence for 50 different criteria meant to measure our progress. We are now recruiting a team of students who will act as auditors, to evaluate this evidence and see if and to what extent we fulfil these criteria.

The two-day audit will take place on September 16th and 17th, 2024, from approximately 9am to 5pm. Students will need to be in attendance for the duration of the audit on both days. This opportunity is open to both undergraduate and graduate students.

A Responsible Futures representative will be on-site and will provide Student Auditors with all the necessary training and support to complete the audit during these two days.

Responsibilities will include:

- Reading through evidence gathered for the audit.
- Assigning points based on the strength of evidence and evaluating how well criterion is fulfilled.
- Interviewing key staff and faculty.
- Recording data and report writing.

Student Auditors will be offered refreshments, lunch, and an honorarium (\$200).

Students interested in becoming a Responsible Futures Student Auditor should submit a brief CV and a short (up to 1-page) expression of interest, including:

- Your name, year, and program.
- Your answer to: Why are you interested to be part of the Responsible Futures student auditor team, and what would you hope to gain from this experience?
