ABOUT THE POSITIONS

- The funded positions include \$35,000 per student, per year, over 4 years.
- Students need to have a Master's degree to be eligible for this funding.
 - This means candidates need to have a Master's degree, or are in a Master's degree program now and will have a Master's degree before entry into our Ph.D. program
- These positions have a **start date of September 2025**, so they are for students applying during the Fall 2024 cycle.
- These positions are open to both International or Canadian students.
