This exchange is open to all undergraduate students at Queen's University to study for a full academic year at the University of St. Andrews. To participate on a Multi-Faculty Exchange you must have your Faculty/School approval.

There is a scholarship available for this exchange courtesy of the Canadian Robert T. Jones, Jr. Scholarship Foundation. The conditions of the scholarship are:

VALUE: CAD \$8,000 per student awarded to four students paid in two installments.

ELIGIBILITY: Students must satisfy the eligibility requirements to study on an exchange as specified by their faculty/school of study at Queen's.

SELECTION: A selection committee will adjudicate the applications and select the winners. Golf skill is not a criterion for selection. *Please note, if selected for an interview, interviews will take place in late January/ early February.*

CONSENT: I authorize Queen's University to release my Queen's academic record to the selection committee for the Canadian Robert T. Jones, Jr. Scholarship.

- A letter explaining why you wish to attend the University of St. Andrews and which contains information about evidenced inter-cultural experiences, work experience, volunteer experience. The letter must be no longer than two pages in length (double-spaced) and contain your signature.
