





## KEY INSIGHTS:

CLAIMS INCREASED FROM 1,050 IN 2017 TO 1,420 IN 2021:

### INCIDENT TYPE:

- **Paramedics**  
60% single traumatic events
- **Other PSPs**  
Higher proportion of **cumulative** traumatic events




How many average days were lost from work across all PSPs?

**422 days**

~14 months

**Paramedics** had higher RTW success rates compared to police, firefighters, and communicators.

### CONCLUSIONS:

Proactive mental health support and prompt RTW interventions are **crucial** for PSPs, especially for those dealing with **cumulative** trauma, to **enhance** recovery and inform future policy and research.

### FUTURE CONSIDERATIONS:

More detailed data and long-term trends are needed to build a more comprehensive understanding.

Addressing combined impacts of operational, organizational, and personal factors on PSP mental health is important.
